Is Your OC Bus Route Changing?

OC Bus service improvements go into effect on Oct. 13, with schedule and route adjustments on about 50 routes.



Route 462 will be replaced with new Route 862 in the Downtown Santa Ana area with 10-20 minute frequency on weekdays and 20 minutes weekends.

Route 211 is being discontinued. Find out more at octa.net.

Say "Yes" to a RideGuide

You have the option to receive a free RideGuide commute planner if you check "yes" to the last question on the annual transportation survey (see story, Left).

The RideGuide gives you commute options such as carpool partners, available vanpools, transit routing and more based on where you live, work and your work schedule.

Even if you currently rideshare, it could be handy to have alternatives in case of an emergency or if your current rideshare arrangement falls through.

Complete and **turn in the annual transportation survey by Monday, Sept. 30, to be entered into a drawing to win one of 10 \$25 Amazon gift cards.**

The survey collects information on how OC employees got to work the week of Sept. 9-13, whether driving alone, carpooling, riding transit or other option. It only takes a few minutes to complete.

Bridging the Gap

After a year of construction, the Slater Avenue Bridge has been reopened—the first of 18 bridges

to be built, widened or replaced as part of the I-405 Improvement Project.

OCTA is overseeing the \$1.9 billion project that will add one regular lane in each direction between Euclid Street and I-605, and a second lane in each direction in the center of the freeway from SR-73 to I-605.

After reopening the Slater Avenue Bridge, OCTA closed Bushard Street and Talbert Avenue bridges over I-405 in Fountain Valley so they can be demolished and reconstructed as part of the project.

Take the Train to Rams Games

Skip traffic and parking costs by taking Metrolink and Metro Rail to Sunday afternoon Rams games. **Metrolink is adding round-trip trains** to Union Station for only \$10, plus free transfers to Metro Rail which riders directly to LA Memorial Coliseum.

Trains will operate on the Antelope Valley, Orange County, San Bernardino and 91/Perris Valley lines. The additional trains will arrive at LA Union Station between 10:40 and 11:30 a.m. and depart between 6 and 7:12 p.m.

Metrolink \$10 Football Trains will run to the end of the regular season, including Oct. 13 (vs. San Francisco 49ers) and Dec. 29 (vs. Arizona Cardinals).
