

LETTER OF UNDERSTANDING
between the
County of Orange
and the
Orange County Employees Association

The County of Orange (County) and the ORANGE COUNTY EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION (OCEA) have met and reached an agreement regarding the performance by County employees in Orange County Public Works (OCPW) of certain services in connection with contracts for projects authorized under Public Contract Code sections 22162.6 and 22162.7 (provided such sections are chaptered by the Secretary of State and become law.)

The parties agree that for any project authorized under Public Contract Code section 22162.6 or 22162.7 County employees in OCPW shall perform:

1. Project development services including performance specifications, preliminary engineering, procurement services, and the preparation of project reports; and
2. Construction inspection services (excluding specialty inspectors); and
3. The preparation of documents that may include, but need not be limited to, the size, type, and desired design character of the project; identification of materials, equipment, and workmanship, and any other information deemed necessary to describe adequately the project for the County of Orange (section 22162.6) or the Orange County Flood Control District (section 22162.7)

This letter shall in no way impact the delivery of any projects executed outside of PCC 22162.6 and 22162.7. In the event of a major deficiency of internal resources, OCPW may provide notice of that condition in writing to OCEA at OCEA's business office at 830 N. Ross St., Santa Ana, CA 92701. Such notice may propose an alternative strategy to perform all or a portion of the services described above. OCEA agrees to meet with OCPW to discuss whether any such alternative strategy is acceptable.
