Adults Served by SSA**



Orange County has a population of 2,000,852 adults between the ages of 18 and 64*. The population decreased by 0.5% from Fiscal Year (FY) 2016-17 to FY 2019-20, and a further decrease of 0.8% is projected from FY 2019-20 to FY 2022-23. SSA provided one or more types of services and assistance to approximately 1 out of every 5 adult residents of the County in June 2020.
