- **Reorganization of Subcommittee by the Emergency Medical Care Committee:**

On the June 26, 2015 Emergency Medical Care Committee members were scheduled to discuss the reorganization of the Education and Training Advisory Subcommittee. This discussion will be tabled to another meeting date. Robert Williams indicated that he had written a letter to Dr. Stratton expressing concerns that the subcommittee is not meeting the needs of the system. He suggested that a steering committee be formed to re-write the Education and Training Advisory Committee bylaws so that the new bylaws may be presented to EMCC to forward to the Orange County Board of Supervisors.

Ernie Foster reminded Committee members that the California Council of EMS Educators (C<sup>2</sup>E<sup>2</sup>) was formed by former members of this Committee as well as counterparts throughout Southern California (such as Riverside and Los Angeles Counties).

Committee members discussed the importance of how this Committee can meet the future needs of the System and the opportunities offered by restructuring the Committee. Committee members have found information presented by EMS staff and also information derived from the meeting to be helpful. They also suggested that a meeting scheduled during a holiday week be rescheduled for another date rather than cancel the meeting.
