Pathways to Well-Being (PWB) Steps to follow when a case no longer meets criteria for Katie A. Cohort.

- A. Once the PWB subclass member is no longer in the child-welfare system, or no longer meets any of the PWB subclass criteria:
1. The ICC Coordinator needs to complete the PWB Eligibility Form only with the following information: clinic name, client's name, DOB, MRN, check "NO" in item 6 regarding client does not meet PWB criteria, date and sign. Support staff will enter this information in IRIS to discharge the minor from the Katie A. Cohort. The termination date will be the date on which the form was signed. Cases are required to be discharged from the Katie A. Cohort when the minor no longer meets criteria.
 2. Modify the Care Plan so the plan no longer authorizes ICC and/or IHBS instead code to Case Management and/or Rehab Services.
- B. In addition, if the minor continues to be eligible for Medi-Cal and meets medical necessity for specialty mental health services as determined by the clinician, the minor may continue to receive mental health services based on their needs.
- C. **Coordinate, Coordinate and Coordinate!** As the Care Plan and other documents are updated, you must notify the other programs of this update as part of the coordination of care.

TBS Services – Progress Notes

TBS Services must be provided under the direct supervision of a Licensed Practitioner of the Healing Arts (LPHA). This includes physicians, licensed psychologists, licensed clinical social workers, licensed marriage and family therapists and registered nurses with a master's degree. If the direct supervisor of the TBS Services is an LPHA, then PROGRESS NOTES are NOT required to be co-signed by the LPHA. On the other hand, if the direct supervisor is not an LPHA, then the PROGRESS NOTES need a co-signature by an LPHA.
